2	Participate in job fair	WYMT-TV's Technical Manager attended Hazard Community & Technical College's Career Fair, on Lee's College campus (Jackson, Kentucky) on April 2, 2008.
3	Participate in job fair	WYMT-TV's General Manager attended Union College's Career Fair, on campus (Barbourville, Kentucky) on November 14, 2008.
4	Participate in job fair	WYMT-TV's General Sales Manager attended Pike County's Career Fair on Pikeville College's campus (Pikeville, Kentucky) on February 26, 2009. This event was a co-hosted by Pikeville College, National College, Big Sandy Community and Technical College, Community Action Partnership and Eastern Kentucky JobSight.
5	Event or program sponsored by educational institution relating to career opportunities in broadcasting	On May 12, 2008, WYMT's morning weather anchor and WYMT's satellite truck operator participated in Lost Creek Elementary's Career Day in Lost Creek, Kentucky. WYMT's staff gave the students a presentation on news gathering, weather forecasting, and satellite truck operation. The satellite truck was on site for tours and demonstration purposes.

6	Event or program sponsored by educational institution relating to career opportunities in broadcasting	The station participates in mentoring and shadowing programs of regional elementary schools, high schools, and colleges/universities. The station allows students to come in and observe station operations, personnel and tasks during business hours. On January 5, 2009, the station allowed 1 mass communications student from Union College to shadow WYMT's news personnel for the day. In February, 2009, WYMT allowed 1 Ohio University communications graduate to shadow WYMT's sports personnel for two days.
7	Event or program sponsored by educational institution relating to career opportunities in broadcasting	The station continually informs elementary and high school students about job opportunities in the broadcast field by sending WYMT-TV staff members to various career fairs and school-sponsored programs. During the school year, Jim's Weather Class is a WYMT program through which teachers can call on the station's weather staff to visit their classrooms and discuss weather forecasting with the students. During this reporting period, WYMT's 6pm weather anchor participated in Weather Classes with Highland Elementary (Paintsville, Kentucky) on September 9, 2008, Prestonsburg Elementary (Prestonsburg, Kentucky) on September 24, 2008, Keavy Elementary (Laurel County, Kentucky) on October 22, 2008, Kimper Elementary (Pike County, Kentucky) on February 4, 2009, Barbourville Independent (Barbourville, Kentucky) on February 18, 2009, South Magoffin Elementary (Royalton, Kentucky) on March 6, 2009, and Harlan Elementary (Harlan, Kentucky) on March 10, 2009. 8	Training of management level personnel as to methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination	All Department Heads, the EEO Administrator and General Manager attended in-house meetings to review the station's EEO procedures and hiring practices on March 4, 2009.
9	Participate in scholarship program designed to assist students interested in pursuing a career in broadcasting	The Ralph Gabbard Memorial Broadcast / Communications Scholarship program is a spin-off of the televised annual WYMT-TV Mountain Basketball Classic project. WYMT appointed an independent Committee (of which WYMT's General Manager, General Sales Manager and News Director are non-voting, active members) to oversee the scholarship selection process. WYMT staff handles most aspects of the scholarship program, including paperwork and correspondence, generating scholarship funds by securing business donations and soliciting Kentucky colleges and universities to match awards, and (in conjunction with the Committee) soliciting scholarship nominees from area high schools. WYMT films, edits and airs features highlighting the scholarship recipients and prints a tournament program highlighting current nominees and past recipients. WYMT also publicizes the scholarship annually in Kentucky's "Affording Higher Education" publication. Three \$1,000 scholarships were awarded in January, 2009 to area high school seniors to assist in their continued education.

10	Participate in scholarship program designed to assist students interested in pursuing a career in broadcasting	The Tony Turner Memorial Broadcast Scholarship program is a spin-off of the annual WYMT-TV Golf Classic project. WYMT established a perpetual endowment fund with the Bluegrass Foundation in order to provide scholarships for aspiring broadcasters from the mountains of eastern Kentucky. WYMT-TV solicits the nominees from area high school guidance counselors, then a scholarship committee which includes three station employees, selects the winners. Collected entry fees for the station's annual Golf Classic, as well as donations from the general public, fund these scholarships. WYMT films, edits and airs a feature news package on the recipient within the golf show. WYMT also publicizes the scholarship annually in Kentucky's "Affording Higher Education" publication. Three \$1,500 scholarships were awarded in March, 2009 to area high school seniors to assist in their continued education.
